We are pleased to invite you all to participate in the Historic Grand Prix Zandvoort. This wonderful event will take place this year on Saturday 20 and Sunday 21 June.

Regularity Drives

To secure more favourable time slots in the schedule and to avoid any reduction in our track time, we will run two 15-minute sessions on Saturday and one 20-minute session on Sunday. As in previous years, these are not races but regularity runs, where you are essentially competing against yourself. The overall winner of these three sessions will be awarded the coveted golden laurel wreath—and with it, eternal glory.



Concours d'Elegance

The Concours in the DVSCC paddock has been a great success in previous years and will therefore return again this year. Enter your car in either the **Original** or **Special** class and stand a chance of winning the "Best of Show" award.

Catering

Following last year's success, the club will once again provide its own catering. Several attractive pagoda tents will be set up, from which we can serve ourselves, and the KONI bus will again be present thanks to Henk Janus. If you choose the catering package, drinks, lunch, and the now traditional Saturday evening Happy Hour will be provided.

Camping

For many years, participants have made use of the opportunity to stay overnight at the circuit in a camper or tent during the Historic GP. It has since grown into a true DVSCC campsite. Those wishing to make use of this can indicate so to the event secretary and will receive further information. Camping is free of charge; a designated area is usually assigned behind the main grandstand, and electricity is available.

Programme

The full programme of the Historic Grand Prix will be available in due course on the circuit's website, where the demo session times will also be published. Alongside the Formula 1 Grand Prix of Zandvoort, the Historic Grand Prix is a highlight on the racing calendar. There will be plenty to see on track and in the paddock throughout the weekend to delight any motoring enthusiast. Bring your pre-war car to the DVSCC paddock, soak up the atmosphere, and enjoy everything on display—even if you do not wish to participate in the demo runs.
